

Know all men by these presents that I Sarah Allerton of Halsworth in the County of Sufft widow do make & ordain by this my last will & Testament in manner & form following, viz. Inprimis, I give to my Son Isaac Allerton nine pounds. Item, I give to my Daughter Mary Anger five pounds, to my Daughter Dorothy Ransham five pounds, to be paid to each of them, my sd Son, & Daughters within one year next after my decease. Item I give to my Son John Allerton five shillings to be paid him within six months next after my decease. Item I give to my Brother Johnson & his wife forty shillings a piece, To my Brother Benjamin Fairfax, my brother John Fairfax, & my brother Nathanael Fairfax five pounds a piece & to each of their wives twenty shillings. Item I give to my Brother Harlock & his wife twenty shillings a piece. Item I give to my Sister Priscilla Fairfax, & my Sister Ann Fairfax five pounds a piece. All with said legacies to my said Brothers & Sisters shall be paid to each of them respectively within one year next after my decease. And in case any of the said last legators my sd Brothers & Sisters, shall dye before my sd legacy be given to any of them to be paid you my said will is that the said legacy of him or her so dying shall be paid to such person or persons as he said legator so dying shall bequeath it to. Item I give unto Sarah, Mary & Elizabeth the Daughters of my brother Benjamin Fairfax aforesaid, & to Elizabeth the Daughter of my brother Nathanael Fairfax aforesaid, & to Sarah the Daughter of my brother Nathanael Fairfax aforesaid, to each of them five pounds to be paid to them & each of them within two years after their respective marriages which shall first happen, together with such improvement as shall be made thereof in the mean time. Item I give my bed full furnished as it stands unto Elizabeth Fairfax the Daughter of my brother Benjamin Fairfax aforesaid. Item I give all the rest of my household-stuffe to be equally divided between my aforesaid Sister Priscilla & Ann, & my sd Sister Elizabeth Daughter of my brother Benjamin Fairfax aforesaid. Item I give to old Goodman Balls of St Michaels & to Goodwife Buller of Rumborough ten shillings a piece, To Alice Richardson servant to me four of Halsworth, & to Mary Taylor servant to my brother Benjamin aforesaid five shillings a piece. Item I give to all the children of my three said Brothers Benjamin, John & Nathanael not before mentioned in this my Will ten shillings a piece. Item I give to the poor of the parish whereof I shall please God to take me away out of this life twenty shillings to be distributed at the discretion of my executor. & to the poor of Rumborough twenty shillings to be distributed in like manner. And all the rest of my Goods, Bills, Bonds, monies, I give to my sd brother John Fairfax of Barking Elthorpe, whom I do hereby nominate appoint & ordain to be the sole executor of this my last will & Testament in witness whereof I gave wrote for my hand and seals this thirteenth day of September in the thirtieth year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord Charles the second, King of England Scotland France, & Ireland, the fourth of the said year of our Lord 1678.
