



High Lodge



High Lodge Leisure, 'High Lodge', is a 48.5 hectare site which lies on the east side of the A12 approximately 2km north of Darsham.

The site has an extant planning permission, granted in 2021, for 170 holiday lodges and associated infrastructure.





Planning Context



- Full planning permission (LPA ref DC/20/3142/FUL) was granted in February 2021 to redevelop the site to provide 170 holiday lodges, 3 tree houses, new Facilities Building, Maintenance and Housekeeping Building, car parking and associated highway works.
- The consent has been lawfully implemented, although it has not been fully built-out.
- The SZC workforce are now proposed to occupy the site for the duration of construction.
- The use of the site by SZC requires minor amendments to be made to the approved development. It should be noted that:
 - There will still be no more than 170 lodges proposed, albeit there will be minor changes to the design of the lodges and the layout of the site.
 - On-site car parking is still proposed, albeit the location of the spaces will change.

Proposed Use



High Lodge site would provide a popular accommodation option for non-home-based SZC workers.

- The accommodation would be for exclusive SZC use,
- offered at a reasonable cost within pre-determined worker allowances in the local area,
- direct bussing to and from the SZC
- High Lodge, also benefits from being closely located to the Darsham Railway Station and the DCO consented Northern Park and Ride site.

Occupancy levels:


- Original consent is 410 single beds and 280 double beds = 970 persons
- Proposed SZC occupancy would be $170 \times 4 = 680$ persons

We anticipate that the number and intensity of traffic movements will be no greater than the consented in the current High Lodge person for tourist use.

Experience from HPC indicates that cost (including the ability to save money on the accommodation allowance via the bussing allowance) and convenience (being able to get on a bus straight to and from site) are particularly important to workers.

Key Considerations



A12 junction improvements


• The previous planning consent secured improvements to the junction. The detailed design is currently being drawn up.

Traffic generation

- The proposal would not alter the proposed distribution of SZC traffic to any great extent. If there are any unforeseen impacts from SZC traffic, then these can be reported and escalated to the Transport Review Group where appropriate.
- SZC workers will be moved to and from the site by bus and not by car, but workers could drive to local amenities such as restaurants after hours.

Other Matters

- EV charging will be available on site, but these would not be available to the wider public.
- SZC has a strict Worker Code of Conduct that would be enforced to ensure appropriate behaviours are enforced.
