Box 3:

The main reason is that the Parish Council received £5595 from East Suffolk Council in Cil money and £350 from the local County Councillor as a grant towards refurbishing the telephone box.

Box 6:

A main reason is that the Council has not spent much this year but will be doing so in 2020-2021. Almost immediately in the new year, they will be spending £5 600 on a new 40mph buffer zone to Bramfield Village, £409 has been spent on a monitor/TV for the Village Hall so that the Council can show documents to the meeting and for the Village Hall to host films etc. The Council has received Cil Money and Grants in 2019-2020 for expected spending on capital projects in 2020-2021.
