Bramfield and Thorington Parish Council raise No Objection to the planning application. The Council remain concerned regarding the density and form of development on the site and the potential impact on neighbouring properties. However, it was noted that this had not been a reason for refusal by East Suffolk District Council or the Planning Inspectorate when considering the previous application. Concerns also remain regarding 4 additional dwellings accessing the Thorington Road in this location but it is appreciated that the best judgement on this matter would be made by SCC Highways.

It was noted that no affordable housing is included as part of the application as only 4 additional properties are proposed. As a wider matter, the Parish Council would be keen to see more affordable housing within the village and smaller open market dwellings (in order to be more attainable for younger families) making up the bulk of any future proposals for new dwellings within Bramfield.

#### d) <u>Acceptance of financial report and year end accounts:</u>

The Clerk reported that this year (2019-2020), the receipts were precept income of  $\pounds$ 5750 plus other income of  $\pounds$ 5957 and including the carry forward of  $\pounds$ 8765 from the year 2018-2019 equalled  $\pounds$ 20472. With payments of  $\pounds$ 5484, this left a carry forward of  $\pounds$ 14 988 to 2020-2021.

The Clerk reported that this year (2020-2021), the receipts were precept income of  $\pounds$ 6000-00 plus other income of  $\pounds$ 4137-25 and including the carry forward of  $\pounds$ 14 987-64 from the year 2019-2020 equalled  $\pounds$ 25 124-89. With payments of  $\pounds$ 11524-95, this left a carry forward of  $\pounds$ 13 599-94 to 2021-2022.

At the end of March 2020 the Community Account had £7415-40 and the Savings Account had £6630-28 which equals £14045-68. However there are four outstanding payments totalling £445-74, the Community and Savings Accounts total was therefore in reality £13599-94.
