There was a change within the Practitioners' Guide 2023 (Applies to the AGAR (Annual Governance and Accountability Returns))

Paragraph 1.26 relates to the requirements in relation to Assertion 3 and states:

Email management - every authority should have an email account that belongs to the council and to which the council has access - this ideally would be a gov.uk or org.uk address or could be an address linked to the council website.

In order to answer yes to Assertion 3 in the 2024/25 Annual Governance Statement, the local authority should ensure that it has an email address that complies with this requirement
